April 11 Reception at the Hotel in Fortaleza by the sea from 2 p.m. Dinner in a restaurant Night Hotel Fortaleza.



April 12 Departure 6 a.m. Bus transfer to the Parnaiba Delta. Lunch on arrival at the hotel located by the sea Dinner and night Hotel.

April 13 Breakfast and bus transfer to the port of Tatu for a boat discovery of the Parnaiba Delta islands Lunch during the visit and arrival in Tutoia!

Transfer from Tutoia to the Porto Preguiças hotel (Hotel located on the banks of the River). Dinner and night.

April 14 Relaxing day on a boat on the Préguiças River (Lunch during the visit) and return early in the afternoon to check the equipment around 4 p.m.!


6 p.m. race briefing, dinner and hotel night.






160 KMNON STOP 100 MILES

Departure at CP1: 30 KM +100 m Seaside, flat CP1 to CP2 18 KM +250 m: Soft sand, dunes and lagoons

CP2 to CP3 23 KM + 600 m Dunes and lagoons
CP3 to CP4 26 KM +500 m Dunes and Lagoons
CP4 to CP5 25 KM + 400 m Dunes and Lagoons
CP5 to CP6 9 KM +200 m Dunes and lagoons
CP6 to CP7 17.5 KM + 600 m Dunes and lagoons
CP7 to Arrival 11.5 KM + 300 m Dunes Lagoons

CP1 Water only, CP2 water, sodas, hot water, CP3 water, sodas, hot water, CP4 water, sodas, hot water, CP5 water, sodas, hot water, CP6 water, sodas, hot water, CP 7 water, sodas, hot water!



### IUU KM35IAGES

First Stage Canto de Atins / Baixa Grande 52 km + 900 meters of D + **CP Lagoa Bonita km 27** 

Second Stage Baixa Grande /Queimada dos Britos 19 km + 200 meters of D + **CP KM 10** 

Third Stage Queimada dos Britos/Santo Amaro 29 km + 950 meters of D +

**CP= 17.5 km** 

No Time limit except on the last stage where you have to complete 5 hours for the 17 km.



### 60 KM 3 STAGES

First Stage Canto de Atins / Baixa Grande

22 km + 600 meters of D +

Second Stage Baixa Grande /Queimada dos Britos

9 km + 200 meters of D +

Third Stage Queimada dos Britos/Santo Amaro

29 km + 950 meters of D +

CP= 17.5 km

No Time limits except on the last stage where you have to complete 5 hours for the 17,5 km.

Difficulties: sand, dunes, heat, sun ...



### ACCOMPANYING PEOPLE

The program is identical to the runners except for the 3 days of racing!

You will witness the start and then you will leave for the first bivouac of the stage races which will also be a CP of the non-stop race! To get to the CP you will have to walk 2 hours! Meals and night at a local's place!

The next day you will have to hike 3 hours to reach CP 2! It will be an active support that will allow you to discover this magnificent desert! Second night with the runners before reaching the finish with the organization shuttle the next day!

For the non-stop race perhaps you will leave before the second night for the arrival of your runner!
